## **Prostate Cancer**


September is Prostate Cancer Awareness Month. According to the American Cancer Society, prostate cancer is the most common cancer among American men other than skin cancer, and is the second leading cause of cancer death in American men, behind only lung cancer. Important risk factors include age, race, and family history. African-American men have the highest death rate for prostate cancer of any racial or ethnic group in the U.S., more than two times higher than in white men. In the last several years, there has been remarkable progress in the development of new diagnostic and therapeutic tools. One of these diagnostic tools, PSMA PET imaging for prostate cancer, is the focus of RTMD's visualization this month. During this awareness month, providers can help increase public awareness about this disease and the importance of early detection, especially for high-risk groups.

- In 2023, it is estimated there will be in the U.S.:
  - **288,300** new cases of prostate cancer
  - **34.700** prostatecancer related deaths
- In 2020, an estimated 3.34 million men were living with prostate cancer in the U.S.


